I go to sleep **after** I look at a book.

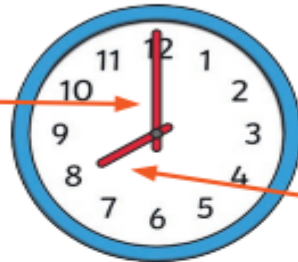

Telling the Time

The **long hand** is the **minute hand**.



The **short hand** is the **hour hand**.

The time is **8 o'clock**.

Telling the Time to the Hour

At the hour, the **minute hand** points to 12.

3 o'clock



6 o'clock



9 o'clock



The **hour hand** points to the hour.

Telling the Time to the Half Hour

At half past, the **minute hand** is half way round the clock pointing to the 6.

half past 1



half past 11







half past 7



The hour hand will be halfway between one hour and the next.

Comparing Time

A  is faster than a .

A  is slower than a .



4 o'clock is **earlier** than half past 4.



Half past 4 is **later** than 4 o'clock.
