We have recently moved our Individual Provision Plans (ISP's) to our online system (EDUKEY), meaning that you are able to access your child's ISP and comment on this from home. Thank you to those parents/carers who have accessed this online. Your comments are vital when discussing your child's provision and arrangements to support them in school. If you haven't had the opportunity to do so, please follow these simple steps below:

To set this up, you were given a unique access code attached to this guidance for you to log in with. You first need to set up an account to gain access – below are the steps to follow to do this.

Go to www.edukeyapp.com/parents

- You will have to enter your email address, the access code and your child's date of birth.
- Tick the small box that says I don't have an account.
- You will then be asked to enter further personal details.
- This will then create an email sent to you to verify your email address. When you have completed this, you will then be able to log into your parent account and view your child's ISP.
- At the bottom of the document is a comments box for you to add your parent comments which will be included on your child's ISP.
