

The very core of our Trust is that we are a family of schools located in the centre of the community we serve. Our SECAT family consists of approximately 3500 children and young people and over 500 staff. 

Just Ride Southend is open every week on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday from 10-12, extended till 1pm in the school holidays if possible, all the way though to December but please always check our latest Facebook Page updates in case we have had to shut at short notice due to weather, illness or track issues.



At *Just Ride Southend* we provide inclusive cycling opportunities for people of all ages (0-97), faiths, abilities, and ethnic backgrounds to enjoy cycling in a safe and affordable traffic-free environment at Garon's athletics track and includes individuals, schools, colleges, home educators, families, adult day centres, care homes, local community groups and adults' rehabilitees from operations and other health issues.

All are assured of a warm inclusive welcome at our 3 weekly drop-in sessions, we are open 48 weeks a year on the track, using over 130 bicycles ranging from children and adult 2 wheelers through to trikes and specialist bikes like our electric powered wheelchair platform bike.

Through our activities we promote the physical, social, and mental health and well-being of our local community and are supporting both local and national initiatives to encourage people to be more active and to choose healthy and sustainable transport options, we also keep the sessions affordable and only charge £2.50 (including use of a bike helmet) to ride for the whole session but carers and parents of children who are riding are free and welcome to ride. The *Just Ride Southend* team is made up of, 40 volunteers from 14yrs + to mid-80's from Southend and the wider area, doing a range of roles including helping set up and put out and away all the bikes, welcoming riders, taking payments, supervising the track sessions and bike mechanics.

There are thousands of children in Essex who have a condition known as Asperger Syndrome (AS). Asperger Syndrome is a form of autism. It is a life-long disability that affects how an individual makes sense of the world, processes information and relates to other people. This form of autism is often difficult to identify and a child could be any age from three upwards before the reason for their difficulty is diagnosed.

Parents say:

- "She doesn't know how to make friends."
- "We could see he was different from other children but people seemed to think it must be our fault. They blamed the parents."
- They thought he was just a naughty boy, but now we know he didn't understand what they wanted him to do."

If you can relate to these comments, it may be that your child has AS.

If so, **ASPERGERS UNMASKED** is intended to give you information, support and advice.

Each child and family is different but many of the challenges they have faced will be similar to yours.

FIRST STEPS


"Once we knew what the problem was we could understand what he needed."

Many of the parents who have spoken to SAFE say that finding out more about AS helped them to develop the confidence to get the best, most appropriate, help for their child and to be able to cope better at home.

- The latest National Autistic Society prevalence figure indicates that there are over 5,000 adults with Asperger Syndrome (AS), most of whom are undiagnosed.
- The ratio is one female with AS to four males.

Is your child looking to learn to play a musical instrument?

Buying a musical instrument can be expensive, particularly when first starting out. At Music on Sea we offer an affordable instrument hire scheme available for all Southend students.

The scheme allows instruments to be hired on a term by term basis for just £30 per term. We offer discounted hire for those in receipt of Free Schools Meals or Pupil Premium Grant, those with an Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plan and young carers. Looked After Children can hire an instrument free of charge.

We currently have a range of instruments available including (but not limited to) Guitar, Violin, Flute and Cello.

Find out if you could be eligible for cheaper mobile and broadband bills

We know people are worried about their bills, so we've worked with internet service providers to deliver low-cost broadband and phone packages called social tariffs.

What a social tariff means

Social tariffs are discounted broadband and mobile deals for people on Universal Credit and other benefits. These tariffs are delivered in the same way as normal packages, just at a lower price. Amid rising living costs, we've been encouraging more broadband and mobile companies to offer social tariffs to help customers on low incomes.

A large number of broadband providers now offer discounted social tariff products, with some offering deals from as low as £15 per month. This could represent a saving of more than £180 per year, which is around 50% compared to the average cost of broadband.


