












Seahorse Class Homework Menu Summer Term 2023

The activities listed below are possible homework tasks for you to complete with your child over the term. Completed activities can be brought into class on any day and there will be an opportunity for completed work to be shared as a class. I would recommend that you only complete and send in one activity a week.

<p>Research a country - Can you find the country on a world map? Can you draw this country's flag? Or write a fun fact about the country?</p> 	<p>Design an alien or space rocket. Write what powers your alien or space rocket has.</p> 	<p>Draw yourself in your future occupation - do you have a special uniform or equipment? Write a sentence about why you want to be a?</p> 
<p>Draw a picture of your favourite things to do at the seaside. Can you label the picture, or write a story set at the seaside?</p> 	<p>Please read/share a story 5 times a week. This can be recorded in your reading record. Key questions can include: What do you think will happen next? How is the character feeling?</p> 	<p>Practice halving, and sharing. You could use raisins, sweets, pencils, toys, or beads to share between 2 or more people.</p> <p>What pattern does your child notice regarding the numbers that can be shared equally and those unequally?</p> 
<p>Investigate objects which float and sink. Then write a list of the objects which float and those which sink. Why are these objects floating or sinking?</p> 	<p>Discussion time - Talk about a favourite trip, why you enjoyed going on that trip, where would you travel to if you could go anywhere?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">?</p>	<p>Continue to use Education City and encourage your child to use technology around the home.</p> 
<p>Make a safety poster - Can you create a poster to help someone? What do you do to stay safe at the beach, crossing the road or using a computer?</p> 	<p>What happens if you place a mirror next to an object? Investigate doubles up to 20.</p> <p>Play pairs or snap - encourage your child to look at the pair or snap cards, what do they notice?</p> 	<p>Design a shield or a crown for a prince or princess. Can you write some words on your design which would describe a prince or princess?</p>
