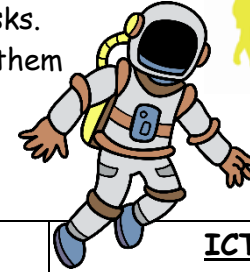
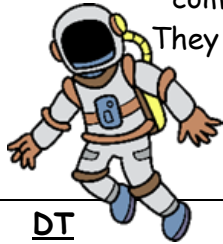





Up, Up and Away Homework Grid Y5 Spring Term 2024

The tasks below are homework activities for your child to choose from over the next term. Please only complete one task each fortnight. The children do not need to complete all the tasks. They can decide which tasks they are interested in and which order they complete them in. Some will be tasks supporting learning, and some will be assessing prior knowledge of a subject. <p><u>DT</u></p> <p>Design and create a solar system using scale to show the relative sizes of the different planets.</p> 	<p><u>English/ Music</u></p> <p>Write a space rap or song - remember that writing lyrics is a little like writing poetry. Think about the beats in each line and if you can create any rhyming couplets.</p>	<p><u>Art/Geogrpahy</u></p> <p>Design an island that you would like to live on. Think about what features it would have, then create a simple key. Use a grid and grid references to show where each feature is located.</p>	<p><u>ICT/ English</u></p> <p>Design a job advert for an astronaut or for a job at NASA. You can handwrite it or type it on a Word document on the computer. Think carefully about the skills required.</p>
 <p><u>History/Art/DT</u></p> <p>Create a timeline to show the history of space travel - be creative! A timeline doesn't have to be 2D...</p>	<p>Up, Up and Away</p>		<p><u>Art/ Science</u></p> <p>Find out about the zodiac star constellation for your birth date. Could you draw it and record some facts about it?</p>
<p><u>DT/Food</u></p> <p>Find (or make up) and make a space themed recipe (be creative!) Take some pictures of you making it and stick it into your homework book. I would love to see how much fun you are having!</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Keep a sky at night journal for a whole week. Write about everything you can see in the sky. You could draw a picture of the moon every night. Does it change over the course of the week?</p>	<p><u>Art/Science</u></p> <p>Create a space-themed_board or card game and teach friends or family members how to play. You could include a space quiz as part of the game - remember you need to know the answers!</p>	<p><u>Art/ Science</u></p> <p>Draw a labelled diagram showing the effects that space has on an astronaut's body.</p>
