‘In the playground, pupils play well with one another. They learn to give and take fairly. Kindness is shown between pupils. Even the youngest children understand and follow the familiar routines.’

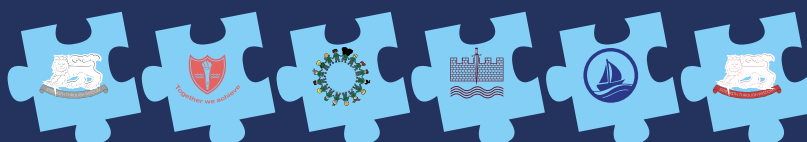
‘Staff are positive role models and encourage pupils to emulate their behaviour. Pupils show respect for others and celebrate differences between each other.’

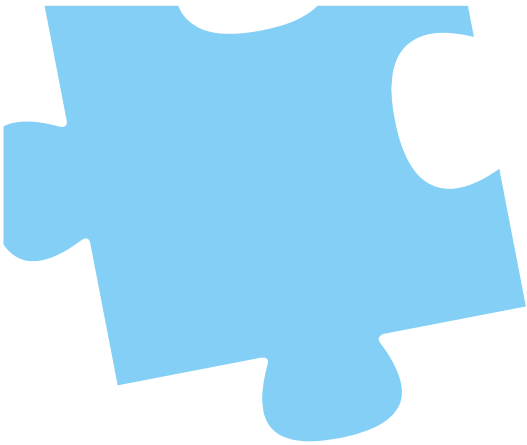
The report also acknowledges that staff who teach and support the children are skilled, have high expectations and secure subject knowledge:
