- Ensure that our learning environment is safe, secure, stimulating and challenging.
- Provide your child with a high standard of education, implemented by rigorous national guidelines, within a balanced curriculum.
- Foster through the school's ethos, behaviour policy and whole school expectations excellence in behaviour.
- Care for your child taking an interest in them as individuals, in their well-being and hold aspirations for each individual's potential.
- Celebrate your child's academic and personal achievements.
- Teach your child to develop a positive attitude to one another, regardless of gender, race, culture, belief, values, age and need.
- Encourage your child to become an active member within our community and help them to see that they can have an impact on the world around them.
- Regularly meet with you to communicate the progress of your child, celebrating their strengths and explaining how together we can support them in their areas for development.
- Provide information to you about our school, including relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities, newsletters and open days.
- Warmly welcome you if you would like to contribute to our school's broader curriculum. We recognise that the community of Hinguar Primary School holds a wealth of talent, experience, diversity and enthusiasm that our school could benefit richly from.
- Set differentiated and achievable homework to extend the curriculum and provide the opportunity for independent learning. Clear information will be provided so that you will be able to help your child if required.
- Provide information and helpful training sessions for you that will give you confidence to support your child.

I, as a Parent/Carer will:

- Make sure that my child attends school regularly and on time.
- Notify the school if my child is unwell and is absent.
- Make sure that all items my child wears to school are clearly named, that school uniform is worn and that their PE kit is in school.
- Communicate any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child's learning or behaviour so this can then be resolved quickly.
- Attend meetings with my child's teacher and other staff, aiming to be positive and productive, working towards moving my child on in their learning.
- Support and work with the school to ensure that the behaviour management policies of the school are maintained, particularly with my child.
- Encourage a positive attitude towards my child's education and our school. If I have any concerns, I will come and discuss them in the first instance with my child's class teacher.
- Ensure that homework tasks are completed and returned on time.
- Read all information sent home as this gives me important details of relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities, newsletters and open days.
- Promptly inform the school office of any changes to contact details and the class teacher of any change to family circumstances that might impact on my child's well-being and learning.
- Provide a positive role model for my child as a member of the Hinguar community.

I, as a pupil of Hinguar Primary School, will:

- Follow the school's rules: Ready, Respectful, Safe.
- Accept responsibility for the things that I do
- Wear the correct school uniform and bring my PE kit to school when I need it
- Try my best to do my work and ask for help if I need it
- Be friendly and caring towards other children and adults
- Be responsible for my schoolwork and homework.
- Respect school equipment and care for my own and other people's belongings
- Tell a member of staff if I am worried or unhappy
- Behave appropriately on the way to and from school
